

Bible Teacher Job Opening

Description:

Shekinah Christian is seeking a full-time Bible teacher to lead the secondary Bible department. The teacher's primary role will be the instruction of secondary students in daily Bible lessons, particularly paying attention to the connection between biblical knowledge and right living and worship. While the Bible is taught as an academic class, we desire for students to develop a deeper relationship with Christ as they grow to know and understand him more deeply as they study Scripture. The proper candidate will have a strong Christian faith that is easily recognized in his lifestyle. Excellent candidates will also be flexible and willing to engage students in mentoring and discipleship roles throughout the school year, helping students connect classroom instruction to real-life scenarios. A bachelor's degree in Bible or ministry is required, and a master's degree is preferred. An educator's license and/or ACSI certification or willingness to obtain is also required.

Requirements

- Be a born-again believer with a lifestyle consistent with biblical principles.
- Possess a thorough knowledge of Scripture and the ability to communicate that knowledge effectively.
- Implement and teach the school-selected Bible curriculum.
- Demonstrate the ability to answer student questions related to the Bible.
- Balance personal perspective of the Bible within a multi-denominational setting being careful to honor the school's statement of faith.
- Differentiate instruction as necessary.
- Develop and implement engaging lesson plans that align with the school's vision, mission, and educational standards.
- Educate students in a classroom setting using best practices that involve real-life applications of the subject.
- Link classroom content with experiential learning outside the classroom.
- Maintain positive relationships with students and parents.
- Keep attendance, grades, and other records for each class in the school management system up-to-date.
- Prioritize the health and safety of all students.
- Participate in and develop ongoing opportunities for personal and professional growth.
- Communicate student issues to families in a timely manner.
