

Elementary Teacher/Supervisor Job Opening

Description:

Shekinah Christian School is seeking an Elementary Supervisor who will lead the elementary program while also teaching part-time within the elementary. Ideal candidates will have a strong history of leadership coupled with a minimum of 5 years of teaching experience at the elementary level. A master's degree is required for this administrative position which reports directly to the Head of School. Responsibilities include but are not limited to: teaching an elementary class (part-time), student discipline, parent communication, program scheduling, curriculum review and selection, leading elementary meetings, assisting teachers with the implementation of necessary differentiation in instruction, and working with the admissions director to properly place incoming students.

Requirements

- Be a born-again believer with a lifestyle consistent with biblical principles.
- · Teach an elementary class.
- · Differentiate instruction as necessary.
- Develop and implement engaging lesson plans that align with the school's vision, mission, and educational standards.
- Educate students in a classroom setting using best practices that involve real-life applications of the subject.
- · Link classroom content with experiential learning outside the classroom.
- · Maintain positive relationships with students and parents.
- Keep attendance, grades, and other records for each class in the school management system up-to-date.
- Prioritize the health and safety of all students.
- Participate in and develop ongoing opportunities for personal and professional growth.
- Communicate student issues to families in a timely manner.
- · Lead the elementary student discipline of SCS.
- · Supervise and direct elementary teachers in their roles.
