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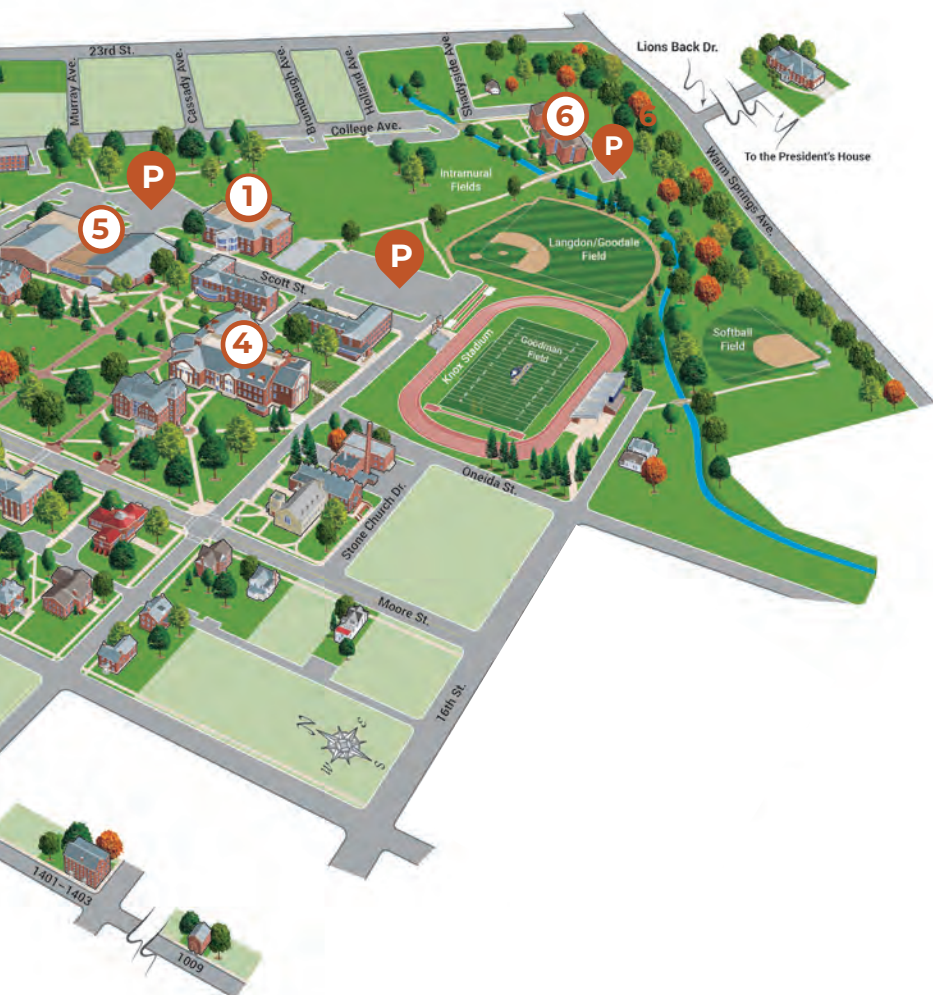
# JUNIATA COLLEGE CAMPUS MAP



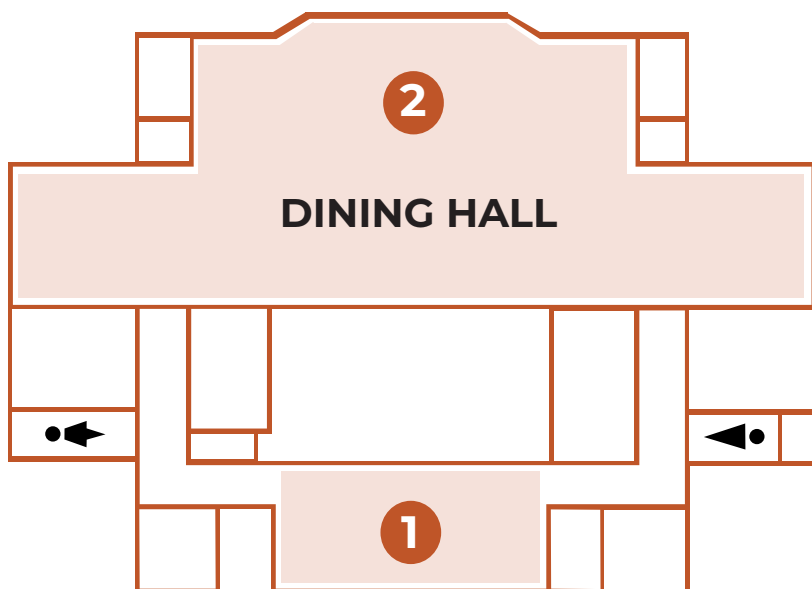

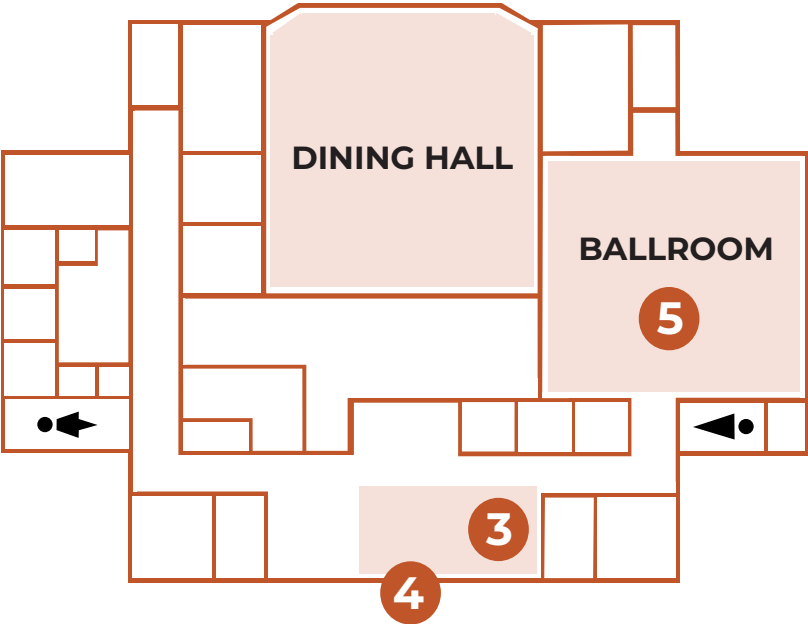
# ELLIS HALL FIRST FLOOR

2. Dining Hall Stage

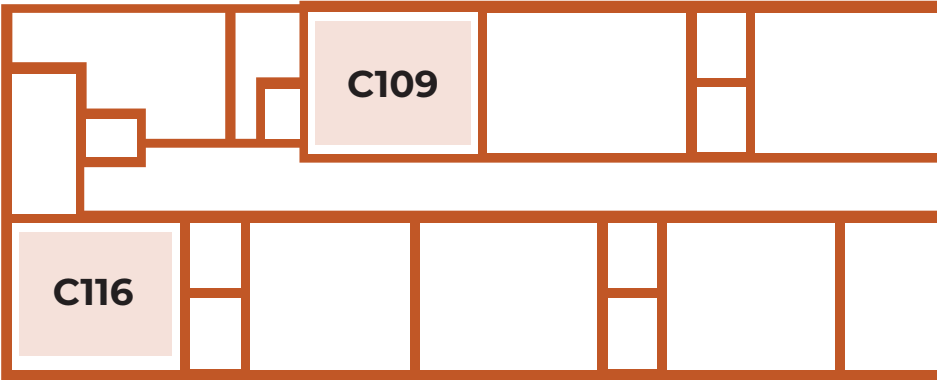
